You will hear less noise around the vehicle, you will smell and breathe less exhaust fumes, and our drivers will comply with local idling laws and regulations. You will notice we, generally, do not leave our motorcoaches running while picking up and dropping off passengers. This helps improve the local air quality by reducing the pollutants for you to breathe in. This also helps reduce health risks for our customers, such as headaches, asthma attacks, cardiovascular damage, and other ailments that can be related to smelling and breathing in vehicle exhaust.

This elimination of unnecessary idling will also help with noise pollution by only using engines when they are needed. Of course, the health and safety of our passengers is of the utmost importance to us, so our drivers will use the heating and cooling systems in the event of extreme temperatures and weather.

We encourage you to ask our drivers about this program. As part of our participation, all of our drivers take EcoDriver and IdleFree trainings, which inform them about anti-idling laws and safer driving techniques. Our drivers will follow these laws for your safety, and the driving techniques they learn will give you a smoother, safer ride while on our coaches. As well, these techniques are better for the engine, require less servicing, and further reduces our carbon footprint giving our coaches a longer life span.
